# TRAVEL UNIFORM DISCUSSION

• A move in the right direction economically to provide uniforms every other year. Our operating expenses such as lights, professional fees, field issues (availability, weather, overuse, field demand, school district renting space to college teams) have increased.

Whitpain \$160/members purchase uniforms Springfield \$188/members purchase every other year Jeffersonville \$200/uniforms included this year Chestnut Hill \$190/uniforms included this year Warminster \$200 Warrington \$345/members purchase every other year

U9 will receive uniforms every year

• After much debate and discussion a motion was made beginning with the 2014 Fall Season to provide U9 travel with uniforms every year.   - o Budget increased budget for Referees, Lighting, Insurance because of known increase



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- Surplus in budget for fields due to the issue of needed additional space for rental.
